**Other Points of Interest:**

- Students must maintain 60% of a full course load (40% for students with permanent disabilities) to be eligible for OSAP (Academic progress is monitored)
- OSAP students are responsible for promptly notifying the Financial Aid Office, in writing if any information provided has changed since the original application.
- All income is verified with Canada Revenue Agency.
- Monies from OSAP are not available before the start of classes, therefore, students are expected to make arrangements to complete an OSAP Tuition Deferral and pay a \$100.00 deposit fee that will be applied towards their tuition.
