

## Uniform and Tool REQUIREMENTS for Hospitality Program Students –B939

1. **Bartending & Uniforms, Footwear & Tools**
2. **Kitchen Uniform, Footwear, & Tools**
3. **Business Suit/Wear**



*Here are details to each of the requirements:*

### **Bartending & Uniforms, Footwear & Tools**

- ❑ plain black long-sleeve dress shirt (uni-coloured, no logos, or patterns)
- ❑ plain white long-sleeve dress shirt (uni-coloured, no logos, or patterns)
- ❑ plain black uniform dress pant  
(worn with plain black leather belt if desired).
- ❑ black vest w. embroidered first name only
- ❑ black zipper-tie
- ❑ black dress shoes
- ❑ black socks

### **Service Tools:**

- ❑ Mini note pad & multiple black ( non logo) pens
- ❑ “Waiter” corkscrew

### **Black Dress Shoes:**

- ❑ polishable, black, closed toe, non-slip, dress shoes (lower heel = maximum heel height of 1.5 inches - a dress shoe would be considered a type of loafer or a pump without laces - platform shoes or boots are not permitted.)
- ❑ plain black dress socks, knee highs, or nylons.

<b>Kitchen Uniform, Footwear, &amp; Tools</b>

### **Kitchen Uniform:**

- ❑ All-white double-breasted chef coat –plain/no logos (unless SCC logo, with your name embroidered)
- ❑ Small-checkered cook's pant
- ❑ All-white Cook's apron (bib style)
- ❑ All-white, plain, linen pillbox cooks hat
- ❑ Kitchen side towels

### **Kitchen Footwear:** *This is an important Health & Safety Code Requirement!*

- ❑ Sturdy, closed toe, grease resistant, polishable, non-slip shoe or full kitchen clog (steel toe recommended) ( black)
- ❑ several pairs of white or black socks

### **Kitchen Tools:**

- ❑ 1 sturdy tool box to hold below items, with lock (like a toolbox made of metal or hard plastic)
- ❑ Pocket thermometer (ideally indicating both Fahrenheit and Celsius)
- ❑ 10 inch French knife
- ❑ 3 inch Paring knife
- ❑ rigid blade Boning knife
- ❑ Swivel vegetable peeler
- ❑ Set of stainless steel measuring spoons
- ❑ Set of stainless steel measuring cups
- ❑ 10 plastic containers ( 2-4 cup volume, can be a disposable Tupperware/Gladware/Ziplock-type)

## Business Suit/Wear

Solid dark Navy or dark Grey being the classic and most professional colour choices for a **business pant suit**. Crisp **white or light blue Dress-Shirt or Blouse** being the classic colour choices to wear with the suit. A fully closed, polishable, solid colour matching, low heeled pair of dress shoes is the professional choice.

*Suggestion: Invest in matching colour business folder or case & other business accessories.*

### Business Suit/Wear, *additional details and tips*

#### Men and Women

- All clothes should be neatly pressed.
- Conservative two-piece pant business suite (solid dark blue or gray is best)
- Conservative long-sleeved shirt/blouse (white is best, pastel is next best)
- Clean, polished, conservative shoes
- Clean and well-groomed hairstyle
- Clean, trimmed fingernails
- Minimal cologne or perfume
- Empty pockets – no noisy coins, • No gum, candy or cigarettes



#### Men

- Necktie should be silk with a conservative pattern
- Dark shoes (black dress loafers or lace-ups are best); clean and polished
- Dark socks (black is best)
- Short hair always fares best in interviews
- Beards & moustaches are acceptable only if keep neat and trimmed
- No earrings
- No heavy cologne



#### Women

• Always wear a suit with a jacket; A dress pant suit instead of a skirt is a preferred choice, however you can opt to choose a business suit with a skirt or have a skirt in addition to the pants. The skirt must be extending over the knee in lengths :

“The right skirt length is critical. If you sit in a chair and can see your thigh or most of the knees with legs crossed or uncrossed the outfit is too short. If your skirt has a slit it should be small, centered in the back, and no higher than the back of your knee. High slits in skirts are never appropriate. A slit should not impair mobility (walking and climbing up stairs). If you cannot walk comfortably in a skirt it is too small or too tight.”

- Do wear low-heeled shoes
- Do not wear open-toe shoes or mules (they are more casual)
- Conservative hosiery at or near skin colour (and no runs!)
- If you wear nail polish (not required), use clear or a conservative colour – consider buffing your nails instead
- One set of earrings only
- Conservative makeup , Conservative accessories
- No heavy perfume, • No heavy cologne

## Note: fitting & other details

- ❑ Freshly pressed/washed and clean/wrinkle free wear at all times.
- ❑ Undershirt or Underwear must not be visible and blend in colour.
- ❑ Fully fitted Uniforms are required by the first day of classes.
- ❑ Pants required to be hemmed neatly
- ❑ Wear your dress shoes to the fitting.
- ❑ Pant hem falls straight on the shoe, but does not sit up -no cuff and no draping.
- ❑ Waist - be sure it fits well - even without a belt
- ❑ Shirtsleeves may require adjustments = not too long
- ❑ (you will not be able to roll or fold them up)
- ❑ Vest - Sides (chest and waist) -trimmed and darted to fit you properly.

It is of the utmost importance that you purchase commercially rated tools. **Do not bring any type of household knives or tools.** Your instructor/s will review your items in the first week of classes for the correct quality.

### Details to FOOTWEAR as part of the Uniform:

Classic conservative business style shoes. Select shoes with good insoles/foot beds, since these are considered your 'work' shoes. You will want to be stylish yet comfortable when wearing them/ standing for long periods of times.
