



## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**Algonquin College of Applied Arts and Technology**

**And**

**Heads of Hospitality and Tourism (HOHTO) - Ontario Colleges**

**Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management Program**

This memorandum of understanding represents an agreement between Algonquin College of Applied Arts and Technology and The Heads of Hospitality and Tourism (HOHTO) – Ontario Colleges .

### **Agreement Overview**

Algonquin College agrees to consider graduates of Hotel and Restaurant Management Ontario College Diploma programs or other programs with equivalent outcomes, for admission into the Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management program. To be considered graduates must meet the following admission requirements and will be required to undertake bridging courses prior to entering the third year of the program. Graduates of other hospitality programs may be considered for admission on a case-by-case basis.

### **Admission Requirements**

Students will have;

- Earned a Hospitality Management – Hotel and Restaurant Ontario College Diploma with a minimum overall average of 70%.
- Completed a minimum of 500 hours work experience within the hospitality industry with an additional 500 hours to be completed prior to degree graduation.

**Bridging Courses**

Successfully completed the following four degree level bridging courses:


1. Communications and Academic Writing (or equivalent academic writing course)
2. Microeconomics
3. Macroeconomics
4. Research (introductory course in research and data analysis)

**Terms of the Agreement**

This agreement shall be effective for a three year term commencing May 30, 2011. Should the agreement necessitate changes these will be communicated to the Heads of Hospitality and Tourism – Ontario Colleges as soon as feasible. This agreement is subject to space availability and may be limited. At the end of this term, the agreement will be subject to review and renewal by both parties. Note, however, that Algonquin College retains the right to modify this agreement.




