

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## Articulation for Hospitality Management (HM) graduates to Bachelor of Applied Business – Hospitality Management (BABH)

**GRADUATES OF ANY ONTARIO COLLEGE HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM** may apply for admission to the BABH program with advanced standings under the following conditions:

- ❑ Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 70% from their College HM program
- ❑ Applicants can apply through OCAS
- ❑ In the case of oversubscription all applicants will be ranked based on GPA
- ❑ These successful applicants will be admitted to a “Transition” Spring term whereby they must complete two phases:

### PHASE 1: ACADEMIC STUDIES

- Financial Management
- Microeconomics
- Macroeconomics
- Fundamentals of Wine and Beverages
- Liberal Studies
- Career Planning and Development

(All BABH graduates must complete 6 Liberal Studies Courses. The student admitted through this mode will be granted 2 Liberal studies exemptions based on their success in two General Education courses in their HM program with a minimum grade of 70%. If the student does not have these credits, the required Liberal Studies courses can be completed anytime during their BABH studies.)

### PHASE 2: COOPERATIVE WORK EXPERIENCE

- Following the successful completion of the academic transition phase students will participate in a Coop Work experience for 520 hours.
- Students will then complete the entire BABH years 3 and 4, including a second coop term with an overall GPA of at least 65%.

Students admitted to the BABH Program in this transition mode will be able to complete the degree in 24 months including 8 months of work experience.
