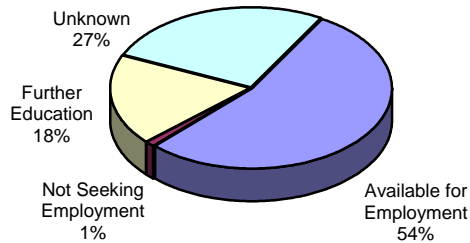
## GRADUATE EMPLOYMENT AND SATISFACTION SURVEY

We are very pleased to present the success of our 2003 graduates. This report is prepared using data from the KPI (Key Performance Indicators) Graduate Employment and Satisfaction Survey. Surveys were conducted by Forum Research Inc., a research firm contracted by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

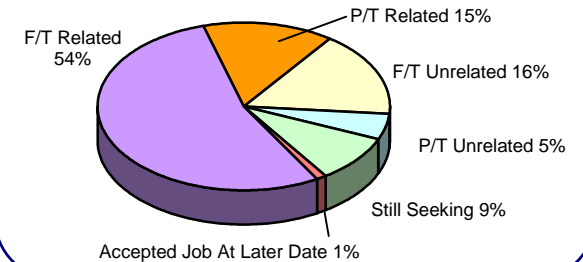
The Graduate Employment and Satisfaction Survey was conducted via telephone interviews with graduates, six months following successful completion of their eligible certificate or diploma program. All Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology followed this procedure.

The information was collected directly from each graduate following the guidelines of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. 73% of graduates completed the survey, thus ensuring reliable data.

## REPORT TERMINOLOGY

**Total Graduates** – Total number of graduates from KPI eligible certificate or diploma program

**Further Education** – Graduates who continued their studies and are not available for employment

**Not Seeking Employment** – Those graduates who were unavailable for employment due to personal circumstances

**Status Unknown** – Graduates who were unable to be located by telephone or who declined to respond

**Available for Employment** – Graduates seeking employment

**Full-Time Program Related** – Graduates who obtained full-time employment (30 hours or more per week) fully or partially related to their field of study

**Part-Time Program Related** – Graduates who obtained part-time employment (29 hours or less per week) fully or partially related to their field of study

**Full-time Program Unrelated** – Graduates who obtained full-time employment (30 hours or more per week) not related to their field of study

**Full-time Program Unrelated** – Graduates who obtained part-time employment (29 hours or less per week) not related to their field of study

**Accepted A Job at a Later Date** – Graduates who accepted a position but started after the specific reference week, and therefore are not included as employed

**Still Seeking a Job** – Graduates who were available for work but not employed during the reference week

**Percentage Working Related** – Number of graduates who found full-time or part-time employment fully or partially related to their program of study, of those graduates available for employment

**Percentage Working** – Number of graduates who found full-time, part-time or other employment related or unrelated to their program of study, of those graduates available for employment

**Minimum Salary** – The lowest salary of all program related full-time salaries reported by graduates

**Maximum Salary** – The highest salary of all program related full-time salaries reported by graduates

**Median Salary** – The point at which there are equal numbers of graduates earning more or less, of all full-time related salaries reported

**Number of Salaries Reported** – Five or more full-time salaries reported by graduates in a related field

**Not Reported (Salaries)** – Salaries are not reported if there are fewer than five program related full-time salaries provided by graduates
