Medical Requirement Form	<p>Assessments and immunizations can take up to two months to complete. Start the process early – as you have accepted your position in the program.</p> <p>Access the forms via the live link under ADMISSIONS tab or PLACEMENT tab on the Respiratory Therapy Program web page: http://www.stclaircollege.ca/programs/postsec/respiratory_therapy/ – look for “HEALTH REQUIREMENTS” to find the Medical Requirements Form.</p>	<p>All students must upload their completed forms to <u>SIS</u> under the tab "Upload Medical Documents". You must <u>fill out the Medical Consent Form as well as the Health History Questionnaire on SIS as well.</u></p> <p>After documents are reviewed and accepted, students will be issued a “Passport to Health” (PPTH) which you can print off from SIS.</p> <p>Students are required to remain up to date with all immunizations & medical requirements throughout the program – keep all documentation.</p>	<p>Nov 30, 2023 – Verification of PPTH must be complete by this date. Program Coordinator will see this within the college’s computer system.</p>

Stethoscope	<p>Students must bring a stethoscope to all lab classes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Littman Classic III is recommended, but any similar device is acceptable. 		<p>Sept 13, 2023</p>
Laboratory Textbook	<p>Lab textbook must be brought to all lab classes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Basic Clinical Lab Competencies for Respiratory Care”; author - White; published by Cengage Learning. 	<p>Textbook can be purchased through campus Bookstore and will be used in all 4 semesters of lab classes.</p> <p>Textbook is required to be brought to all lab classes.</p>	<p>Sept 13, 2023</p>
