- Teaching experience at the post-secondary level with a demonstrated application of adult educational principles and teaching/assessment methodologies would be considered an asset;
- Demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching and learning and proven approach to life-long learning;
- Excellent organizational and time management skills;
- Superior interpersonal skills with demonstrated strong oral, written, and electronic communication abilities;
- Strong computer skills;

- Self-motivated and independent who also functions well in a team environment;
