Position Summary:

Reporting to the Chair of the School of Health Sciences, the Junior Technologist B supports lab instruction within the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program. The Technologist guides students during scheduled lab sessions as they practice skills previously taught by the instructor. Responsibilities include helping students understand course concepts, supporting in-process assessments, preparing lab equipment, and maintaining a safe and effective learning environment.

Summary of Duties:

Based on the course syllabus and instructor-taught theory, the Junior Technologist B:

- Supports students during lab sessions, reinforcing concepts and techniques introduced by faculty.
- Provides guidance on correct scanning procedures, machine operation, ergonomics, and image optimization according to program standards.
- Prepares laboratory equipment, simulators, and scanning rooms prior to labs; ensures materials are organized and ready for use.
- Performs routine equipment checks and coordinates maintenance needs; assists with evaluating and recommending new lab resources.
- Monitors lab safety, ensures appropriate use of equipment and maintains a professional learning environment.
- Assists instructors by observing student performance and providing feedback contributing to formative assessments (without independently grading or evaluating).
