

2019-2020 Scholarship Information

The St. Clair College Foundation seeks and obtains support from companies, organizations and individuals, to make a number of scholarships available to full-time St. Clair College students. A Scholarship is a gift of money awarded to a deserving student by a sponsoring organization, corporation or individual. A T4A slip will be issued for income tax purposes.

- Applications open on October 1, 2019. Applications are available online only and only one application is required. Deadline is December 20, 2019 at 4pm.
- Scholarships are available to full-time St. Clair College students who have a satisfactory academic standing (minimum Grade Point Average of 2.0 and higher).
- Applications are available through your mySt.Clair account during the application time period. Once you have logged into your account, Click on the "Scholarship" tile to complete application
- You will need to have your SIN number, summer & school gross earnings, any OSAP amounts received, and everyday general expenses for all semesters (gas, clothing, bus etc.).
- The successful candidate for each scholarship will be notified by email in February.
- All communications from the Advancement Office to you will be done through your St. Clair One email (your College issued email address).
- In order to receive your scholarship funding, you must attend the February/March ceremonies, and provide a thank you card the night of for the scholarship donor.
- All Applications are submitted through your mySt.Clair account.

A Scholarship selection committee made up of Faculty, Chairs & Administration from the College meet to select the successful candidates for these scholarships. Only successful candidates will be notified regarding the status of their application. Scholarships will be awarded at the Scholarship Award Presentation in February/March.
