- Approval of previous minutes (November): Trevor Ramieri and Rishi Vatish
- Items:
 - **Rez Talks** – Ambassadors and Laura are hoping to create a series of Rez Chats for further peer discussion/information sharing related to the topics reviewed during the previous meeting. Discussed ways to enhance participation, specifically at Q-Hall. Krystal noted that sharing more information on the posters may help. The group discussed moving the location of where the group is held as well.
 - **Documentary Screenings – W'at About Us and What We Deserve** – Brief group discussion about facilitating this screening, including objectives and intended outcomes. The group decided to not pursue the documentary screenings at this time.
 - **Bringing in the Bystander** – Currently working on dates for the new semester.
 - **CK Based Group for Self-Defense** – Holly and Laura met with the group and decided not to pursue it as objectives did not align at this time. Laura is looking into alternative training. Rishi suggested that self-defense programming be offered/available to all students
 - **Presenter – Bonny Shade (keynote)** - Confirmed that Bonny has been booked to attend St. Clair College on March 27th to provide a keynote regarding SV and consent. Currently the St. Clair Centre for the Arts has been booked but group discussion took place about possible alternative locations to enhance attendance.
