• Items:

- o Terms of Reference: The Terms of Reference have been updated and are attached to these minutes. Please review for any additional changes or recommendations. Ryan inquired about faculty representation on the committee. Laura will explore.
- o **Self-Defense Course –** This has been confirmed for Saturday, Oct 18th from 9-12 in the Mezzanine. This course will be open and free to all students.
- o **Flip the Script** The SARE Centre through the University of Windsor will be facilitating the group Sept 18th, 25th, Oct 2nd and 9th at South Campus from 6-9pm. Advertising and recruiting participants will begin soon.
- o Mocktail Mingle- Group discussion regarding this event and the positive feedback last year. The event was hosted at South Campus the first week of school in the SLC in partnership with the SVP Committee and SRC. The event was also hosted at the Chatham Campus (closer to Halloween) in partnership with the SVP Committee and TSI. Rishi and Suhas confirmed that they will look into scheduling and events, as many events are taking place the first few weeks of school. Both will reach out to Laura.
- o **Bringing in the Bystander** New policy/mandate in place that limits the use of suppliers/services outside of Canada. Currently awaiting confirmation that the College can continue to utilize the BITB Program.
- Booths/Engagement Suhas brought forth a discussion regarding how to have students engage more with the weekly SVP booths on the Campuses. Discussing regarding updating materials/ resources. Alysa shared her suggestions for hosting events/activities to engage students (i.e. fun wellness activities). Laura also shared that we are still in the process of recruiting Ambassadors and the importance of the student voice/role.
