- Approval of previous minutes (September 10th): Krystal Liu and Laura Crowley
- Items:
 - **Welcome** – Sandra Brochu – REES Student Ambassador. Sandra provided a bit about her role with REES and how she is looking to expand the St.Clair Community awareness of REES.
 - **Self-Defense Course** – Reminder that this will take place Saturday, Oct 18th from 9-12 at South Campus.
 - **Flip the Script** – Will take place Nov 22nd and Nov 23rd from 10am-5pm. Posters to go up soon.
 - **Mocktail Mingle:**
 - **Chatham** –Oct 28th 3-5pm – all are welcome
 - **South Campus** – TBD – looking at early January. Rishi shared ideas of tying in an uplifting event to promote wellness/ party safe as January is typically known as a “blue month”. Darrelle added that many individuals practice “dry January”. Rishi and Laura will connect further to plan (tentatively looking at early January)
 - **Bringing in the Bystander** – Two trainings sessions are being offered for all students (Oct 23rd and Nov 13th). Posters have been distributed and information shared with student leaders, residences, and soical media.
 - **Rez Chats** – In the process of scheduling with the residences.
 - **REES Ambassadors** – Discussion regarding the use of Rees and if the College should continue to use the platform. Laura shared insights regarding usage and awareness. Overall the group agreed that there is a lack of awareness/understanding of Rees. Sandra suggested using QR codes on the

posters versus a website. She also suggested a poster contest and tabling information booths. Hailie brought up hosting a “meet Rees event”. Krystal shared some feedback that it might be helpful for students to know more about the confidentiality/anonymous aspect, why it’s important to document, and review that police do not get automatically called. Greg brought up using the resources for other means to support students, if Rees isn’t being utilized. Alysa shared that she’d like to see Rees stay as a resource for students but felt more awareness is needed. Shubham also agreed that awareness is lacking but offered TSI support to table information or to use an incentive.

- **Condoms and Consent** – Natalie from SRC approached the SVP Committee regarding a possible partnership involving a Condom packaging contest amongst students. Discussed tying in Condoms and Consent. Laura will work with the Ambassadors and SRC.
