

Third Year Dental Hygiene Program

(Dental Hygiene Year 3 - Fall 2020)

The following list of questions may help you prepare for this fall:

1. Will there be a clinic orientation?

2. Do I need a current CPR, First Aid and T.B. skin test?

Yes, you are required to have a **current HCP-level C CPR with AED awareness and use of ambu bags, T.B. skin test** and a **standard First Aid** certificate to be able to provide client care in our clinic.

A one step T.B. skin test form is included.

You will be unable to enter clinic if you do not provide a current CPR, First Aid and T.B. skin test

Please bring your passport to health and TB skin test to the campus nurse to be updated. Once the passport is updated, please bring ALL medical forms to the Registrar's office prior to the first day of clinic.

3. When will clinic start and what are my clinic times?

4. What textbooks will we be using for year 3?

Please contact the campus bookstore for textbooks required for year 3 of the dental hygiene program.

5. Will I need an "enhanced" Police Clearance this year?

Yes, you will need an enhanced police clearance for your offsite community placements and CDHO registration (enhanced refers to working with the vulnerable sectors of the population). The enhanced police clearance needs to be less than a year old when applying for CDHO registration; therefore, we recommend obtaining in July or August this summer.

Please contact your hometown police station to verify their process. You will be asked to submit your police clearance during the offsite orientation sessions in **September 2020**.
