

Removing Previous Courses From Blackboard

Even though courses are periodically removed from Blackboard once they hit a certain age, you may still find that your list of courses that show up can grow to be cumbersome, sometimes even making it difficult to locate your current courses for the semester. Fortunately there is a simple way to remove them from your course list on your own while on the My Institution page (The page at which you arrive immediately upon logging in). As per below you will notice the module called My Courses:



Within the title bar of the My Courses module is a gear shaped icon that indicates the tool tip "Manage My Course Module Settings". Click that icon as per below:



At the next page (Personalize: My Courses) simply click the Select All/Unselect All option twice for each course that you no longer require. With all items deselected for the courses you no longer require, click Submit. The courses that you had deselected will no longer show, and you can go back and re-select them at a later date if necessary.
