GRADUATE INFORMATION

All graduates of the above programs must pick up their grad pack between 12:00 p.m.-1:00 p.m. and begin to assemble in the WFCU main bowl lower level (follow signage to marshaling area) by 1:15 p.m. Graduates must be in their alphabetical sequence in the marshalling area by 1:45 p.m. so the graduate procession can begin. Gown rentals will close at 2:00 p.m. once the ceremony starts, no refunds.

Late graduates will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.

ACADEMIC GOWNS AND RENTAL

You can rent your graduation gown online for \$20 (tax included), until **January 20, 2020 (at 5:30 p.m.).** After January 20, gowns can be rented the day of Convocation at the WFCU Centre for **\$75 (CASH ONLY with a \$40 refundable deposit upon return of gown).**

Late graduates will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony and NO REFUNDS will be given on pre-ordered gowns.

All gowns must be returned promptly after your Convocation ceremony has finished. Thank You.

Caps and tassels will be available for purchase in the gown area as souvenirs only. Note that they cannot be worn during the ceremony.

All candidates who participate in the Convocation sessions must be in academic gowns. **No flowers/corsages, hats or purses are to be worn or carried during the ceremony**. Purses should not be taken to the marshalling area, so please leave them with a friend or family member.
