Uniforms:

Students are required to wear the Esthetician program **grey scrubs** and soft-soled shoes (i.e., running shoes) in labs, as part of our workplace safety protocols. No open-toe shoes, crocs, boots, flip flops, flats, or heels.

The cost of the Esthetician scrub set is **\$46.00 +tax**, available at the college bookstore. It is highly recommended that you have at least 2 sets, as you will be wearing them daily. (Over and above the Program uniforms, you can purchase additional plain medium grey scrubs.)

As part of your tuition, you will receive a kit that includes the essential supplies and equipment needed for your practical applications. You will receive your kit in the first 2 weeks of class.
