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## **1.5.6 STUDENT OVERALL STANDING**

### **Introduction**

This Policy defines “Student Overall Standing” as it relates to behavioral misconduct and is an extension of Policy 1.5.1 “Academic Standing”. Also forming part of this Policy, is the document “A Student of Good Standing as Defined by the Registrar’s Office”, which generally reflects the current College understanding of “Good Standing”.

### **Policy**

Any behavioral misconduct by a student that results in a notice of disciplinary action by the College will automatically remove that student from a “Student in Good Standing” designation to a “Not in Good Standing” category. The “Not in Good Standing” status will be in effect until the end of the Academic term following a period of one full year from the date of the notice of disciplinary action to the student.



**A STUDENT OF GOOD STANDING**

**AS DEFINED BY THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE**

1. **Academic Good Standing:** A student will receive academic good standing at the end of a semester when the student has successfully completed **fill** courses, he or she receives a Grade Point Average of 2.00 or greater and is not on:

- Academic Warning
- Probation
- Dismissal

2. **Good Standing:** As defined by the Registrar's Office, a student is considered to be in "Good Standing" who:

1. Is in Good Academic Standing
2. Is not on any of the following:
  - A behavioral contract
  - A suspension
  - Under a trespass notice with the College
  - Flagged in the SIS by the Associate Vice President, Student Services & Registrar or Associate Registrar
